5. NEW BUSINESS

- A. Consideration of amendments to the Amended and Restated Bylaws of the Authority adopted February 8, 2019 and last revised February 9, 2026, by revising paragraph 3 of Article VII (“Officers”) and paragraph 6 of Article VIII (“Meetings”) to clarify the process of setting an agenda, where the City Manager Officer, Town Mayor Officer and County Administrator Officer prepare a draft agenda for the Chairman’s approval and if the Chairman does not reject or modify the draft agenda, such draft agenda becomes the agenda, which can be changed by the Chairman during a regular meeting; and by revising paragraph 5 of Article VIII (“Meetings”) to provide that the Secretary may adjust the time or date of a meeting if the Secretary determines that the Authority’s directors and/or alternates will unlikely meet quorum requirements for a meeting [no written resolution] – Megan J. Holley, Esq., Christian & Barton, L.L.P., Authority Legal Counsel.
- B. Consideration of Resolution No. 2026-07-13-5B, authorizing the negotiation, execution and delivery of a contract with Sellers Brothers, Inc., a Virginia corporation, for the construction of a gravel drive on an easement to be granted by Avio as approved in Resolution No. 2026-06-08-5B in order to resolve certain title issues related to Project Volare, the cost of such contract not to exceed \$300,000.00 – Matthew D. Rowe, Director of Economic Development, Pittsylvania County
- C. Consideration of Resolution No. 2026-07-13-5C authorizing the Authority to establish a bank account or accounts with First National Bank, and to close any or all bank accounts currently open with First Citizen’s Bank - Kim Van Der Hyde, Director of Finance, Pittsylvania County, Virginia

6. CLOSED SESSION

As permitted by Virginia Code § 2.2-3711(A)(39) for discussion or consideration of records excluded under Virginia Code § 2.2-3705.6(3) (including without limitation (i) those certain confidential proprietary records voluntarily provided by private business pursuant to a promise of confidentiality from the Authority, and used by the Authority for business and trade development and (ii) those certain memoranda, working papers, or other information related to businesses that are considering locating or expanding in Virginia, prepared by the Authority, where competition or bargaining is involved and where disclosure of such information would adversely affect the financial interest of the Authority); such information being excluded from mandatory disclosure under Virginia Code § 2.2-3705.1(12) (information relating to the negotiation and award of a specific contract pertaining to the Authority's Southern Virginia Multimodal Park, where competition or bargaining is involved and where the release of such information would adversely affect the bargaining power or negotiating strategy of the Authority) and Virginia Code § 2.2- 3705.1(8) (appraisals and cost estimates of real property in one or more of the Authority's projects subject to a proposed purchase, sale, or lease, prior to the completion of such purchase, sale, or lease); and
- C. As permitted by Virginia Code § 2.2-3711(A)(3) for discussion or consideration of the acquisition and/or the disposition of publicly held real property, where discussion in an open meeting would adversely affect the bargaining position or negotiating strategy of the Authority; and
- D. As permitted by Virginia Code § 2.2-3711(A)(8) for consultation with legal counsel employed or retained by a public body regarding specific legal matters requiring the provision of legal advice by such counsel; and
- E. As permitted by Virginia Code § 2.2-3711(A)(29) for discussion of the award of a public contract involving the expenditures of public funds where discussion in an open session would adversely affect the bargaining position or negotiating strategy of the Authority.
